It has been a few weeks since I got your glo-jo product, but we finally got a fire to test it out on. We had a large industrial plant catch on fire last Thursday night. Upon arrival it was 1/3 involved. I packed up and turned on the Glo-Jo band on my helmet. A team of us made entry and it was the first time I had used your product on the fire ground. We were inside for a short while, as deteriorating conditions forced us to leave and make a defensive stand. Once outside EVERY member of our entry crew (6+) asked what was on my helmet and said that they wanted one immediately. One firefighter said that as black as it was inside the brightest thing out of all of our gear, hand lights, etc., was the helmet band. He said that it lit the place up and made identifying where we were instantaneous. We are in the process of a departmental review of this product. I know that several firefighters will be contacting you shortly to purchase one on their own to have one in their hands faster. This is a highly innovative product that after 8 straight hours in < 28 degree temperatures and tens of thousands of gallons of water later it was still working perfectly. Even the batteries held up for that time-frame in the winter conditions. I highly recommend your product.
